This is the final part of the magisterial three-volume biography of Winston Churchill (following Visions of Glory, 18741932 and Alone, 19321940) from National Humanities Medal and Abraham Lincoln Literary Award recipient William Manchester, who, in failing health, turned to Paul Reid to finish the book. It picks up shortly after Winston Churchill became Prime Ministerwhen his island nation stood alone against the might of Nazi Germanyand conjures up a man of indomitable courage, lightning fast intellect, and an irresistible will to action. "Manchester has such control over a huge and moving narrative, such illumination of character," wrote Alistair Cooke in The New Yorker, ". that he can claim the considerable achievement of having assembled enough powerful evidence to support Isaiah Berlin's judgment of Churchill as 'the largest human being of our time'." 1183.
